COED Slow Pitch Softball Rules

1. Rosters: All rosters must have at least 10 players (maximum 14). Players must appear on the roster to be eligible to play in the immediate game.
Players must be 16 years old to be on the roster and play.
2. All teams must have at least 50% female players playing offense and defense.

Batting order for Players:

- 1.F
- 2.M
- 3.F
- 4.M
- 5.F
- 6.M
- 7.F
- 8.M
- 9.F
- 10.M

- If a female is missing to start the game, you may take an out from any female spot in the order.
 - If there is a female missing, you may only have 3 outfielders.
- If a female is missing to start the game, you may take an out from any spot in the lineup.
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Batting Order: Players may re-enter the game at any time in the same batting position if they are batting everyone. Teams pick their line-ups and bat as many as they like as long as they alternate between Female and Male.

Game Layout: Games are 7 innings or 1 ½ hours, whichever comes first. No new inning can be started within 5 minutes of the next game time. If the 1 ½ hours expires during an inning, the final score is that of the last completed inning.

***Players should not be on the field more than 30 minutes before the game and off the field within 5 minutes after the end of the game.

1. Start of Games: Captains or team reps should meet with the umpire 5 minutes before the scheduled start time. Play must start on time! A minimum of 9 players, including 3 females and 3 males are needed to start. The game clock will start on time.

2. Players on the Field: there must be 4 females in the field, with 2 in the outfield and 2 in the infield (any position). If you hit more than 10 players, you may substitute freely in the field as long as this rule is followed.

3. The Home team is responsible for keeping the official sheet.

4. Injuries: If a player is injured on the field and you have no subs on the bench, you can play with 9, but the injured player's spot in the order is an out. If the injured player is a female, you need at least 1 female infielder and 1 female outfielders.

5. Courtesy Runner: If a player has a previous injury or gets injured in the game and requires a runner, the last batted out will be the courtesy runner. If it is a female the runner must be the last female that made an out. If male the runner must be the last male that made an out.

6. No Bunting: Any full swing that is fair is playable.

7. Home Runs: You may hit unlimited home runs.

8. Pitching: Pitcher MUST be on the rubber at time of release of pitch. The ball must reach a height of 6ft off the ground and cannot go above 10 feet. The speed must be slow.

9. Run Rule: A 12 run rule will be in effect for all games. A team ahead by 12 or more runs at the end of the 5 innings (4 ½ if the home team is ahead) shall be declared the winner.

10. Leading/Stealing/Sliding: There is no leading until the pitch reaches the plate. Absolutely no stealing! Sliding is allowed: Absolutely no take out slides (determining factor is intent, and if runner cannot reach base during slide) or intentional interference with a defensive player.

11. Equipment: Absolutely NO metal spikes allowed. Metal bats are acceptable; bats need to be softball, not baseball bats.

12. Alcohol/Smoking/Trash: Smoking and alcohol are not permitted at any of the fields before, during or after the game. Please treat the city fields with respect. Pick up all trash.
